Under this agreement for 2017 Burrowes State School will receive

\$579 772

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard from 81% in Year 3 reading to 90% over two years.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard from 77% in Year 5 reading to 90% over two years.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard from 78% in Year 3 numeracy to 90% over two years.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard from 80% in Year 5 numeracy to 90% over two years.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands (U2B) for Year 3 and 5 Reading and Numeracy to reflect statistically similar to Queensland.

Our initiatives include


- Implementation of intensive school wide focused intervention. Employ and train teacher aides to deliver program under the supervision of Head of Curriculum.
- Employ specialist Literacy Teacher to work with teachers and cohorts of students to enhance Literacy pedagogy across the school.
- Employ specialist Numeracy Teacher to work with teachers and cohorts of students to enhance numeracy pedagogy across the school.
- Purchase literacy and numeracy resources to support programs.
- Employ additional teacher allocation to support each year level literacy and numeracy needs through differentiation.
- Employ a Speech Language Pathologist (0.6) to assess all Prep students, maintain the structured oral language program for implementation by teachers and teacher aides. Monitor student progress.
- Employ a teacher (0.6) to focus on Year One intervention for students who need further support after Prep.
- Provide opportunities to release teachers for moderation, planning and differentiation with a specific focus on implementing our Guaranteed Viable Curriculum.
- Employ a Community Education Counsellor to work with at risk Indigenous students and families and monitor attendance, behaviour and academic progress.
- Provide an opportunity for all Year prep and One students to have a hearing screener.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

1. Literacy and numeracy resources	\$ 30 000
2. Specialist Numeracy Teacher	\$ 90 000
3. Specialist Literacy Teacher	\$ 90 000
4. Prep Start and Strong Foundations language program	\$124 000
