Under this agreement for 2020
Burrowes State School will receive

\$723,151.00

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Year 3 & 5 in Reading (Year 3 & Year 5 – 95% in 2020)
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands in NAPLAN Year 3 & 5 in Reading (Year 3 & Year 5 – 25% in 2020)
- Enhance reading capabilities of students Prep-Year 6 (Rip into Reading Program)
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or better in English & Mathematics (Years 1-6) from an average of 55% Semester 1 2019 to 65% Semester 1 2020 (English) & 65% Semester 1 2019 to 70% Semester 1 2020 (Mathematics)

Our initiatives include

- Employ a Head of Department (Curriculum) to support key school priority areas and provide modelling, coaching and feedback to staff to enhance teacher pedagogy and ultimately student outcomes
- Employ a Deputy Principal to assist with operational processes and protocols
- Employ classroom teachers to lower class sizes and enhance student learning
- Employ an Art Therapist to work with identified students with complex needs and trauma (three days a week)
- Employ a Play Group Co-ordinator to promote community engagement (Early Years initiative)
- Employ a Speech Pathologist (.6) to focus on Early Years (Prep-Year 2) identified students that require further support with their learning
- Employ a Behaviour Support Teacher Aide
- Purchase Teacher Aide hours to support student learning and school support programs
- Provide release days for teachers to work with their respective HOD (Curriculum) and unpack the Australian Curriculum and accompanying assessment tasks. Moderate units with their peers local/cluster
- Employ a second EALD teacher and extra EALD Teacher Aide Hours to support EALD student learning
- Professional development for staff, focusing on school priority areas
