This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students at or above National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Years 3 and 5 in Literacy from 2018 (Year 3 - 81% & Year 5 - 79%) and Numeracy 2018 from (Year 3 - 83% & Year 5 - 90%) to an average of 85% or greater in 2019
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands (U2B's) in NAPLAN Years 3 and 5 2018 Literacy and Numeracy by +5% in 2019
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or better in English and Mathematics (Years 1-6) from an average of 61% in English and 63% in Numeracy in Semester 1 2018 to 70% in Semester 1 2019

Our initiatives include

- Maintain embedded intensive school focused intervention programs. Employ and train teacher aides to deliver programs to identified students under the supervision of the Head of Curriculum (HOC)
- Employ a HOC Student Services to work with teachers/students re behavioural management strategies
- Employ a Chaplain an extra two days a week to support school based programs and student and staff health and well-being
- Employ a teacher (0.22) to support EALD specialist teacher with large number of EALD students enrolled
- Employ an Art Therapist to work with identified students (two days a week)
- Purchase Literacy and Numeracy Resources to support intervention programs
- Employ a Speech Pathologist (0.6) to assess all Prep students, and maintain the structured oral language program that is implemented by teachers and teacher aides, to monitor student progress
- Employ a teacher (0.6) to focus on Year 1 identified students that require further support in their learning
- Provide release time for teachers to work with the HOC and unpack the Australian Curriculum and accompanying assessment tasks. Moderate tasks with their peers
- Provide opportunities for all Prep and Year 1 students to have hearing tests

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employment of a teacher for Year 1 Intervention Program (0.6)	\$54 000
• Playground Early Learning – Langtry and Church	\$40 000
• Employ a A/HOC Student Services	\$115 000
• Employ a TA004 Behaviour (Teacher Aide)	\$58 000
• Increase Chaplaincy – extra two days a week	\$30 000
• Employ teacher to support EALD specialist (0.22)	\$22 000
• Purchase of extra Teacher Aide hours for Prep (25 hours per week)	\$40 000
• Employ Art Therapist (two days per week)	\$28 000
• Teacher release to enhance data literacy skills and teacher pedagogy	\$60 000
• Employ A/HOC Student Learning	\$115 000
• Purchase of Literacy and Numeracy Resources to support student learning	\$42 965
