Learning and Assessment this Term

English:

In English we are learning to listen, talk and connect with a story. We are also learning about sounds.

Mathematics:

Numbers, numbers, numbers! We are learning all about our numbers from 0 to 10 **HASS:**

We are looking at different types of families and the way they celebrate important events. **PE:** This term students will explore how to move and play safely during physical activity. They will develop the fundamental movement skills of running, jumping, hopping and galloping.

The Arts: The Arts: We will be learning about and exploring the basic concepts of art such as line, shape and colour.

Languages: This term students in years P-2 will learn about the Chinese culture and use basic Chinese language within the classroom setting. They will demonstrate their understanding by following simple instructions in Chinese.

<u>Classroom Expectations and Routines</u>

- School starts at 8:30am, if your child is running late, you must sign them in at the office and present a late slip to the classroom teacher.
- If your child is sick, please phone the office on **3802 3333** to inform them that your child will not be attending school on that day.
- Before school, all students are to sit in a line outside of their classroom ready for the bell to ring. If you need to talk to a teacher, please contact your teacher via email to make an appointment with them either before or after school. Due to preparing for the day, teachers are not to be disturbed unless there is an emergency or you have made an appointment. Thank you for your understanding.

Playground before and after school

Just a reminder to ensure the safety of our students, that there should be **no prep students or their siblings on the playground and play equipment before and after school.** Thank you for understanding the importance of this issue as we endeavor to keep students and children safe. In the morning, students are to be lined up outside of the classroom ready for the bell.

Positive behaviour for learning (PBL)

Burrowes are a PBL school and encourage students to earn merit points which reflect their achievement in our four pillars of PBL: I am safe, I am respectful, I am responsible and I am a learner. Every term, we celebrate our student success with a Celebration Day. Each fortnight students focus on a different PBL rule to help them succeed in our school environment. Below are the weekly focuses

Week 1 & 2: am an all rounder – I will understand my emotions

Week 3 & 4: I am a learner when I use strategies to stay in the green zone.

Week 5 & 6: I make safe choices when I'm in the red zone.

Week 7 & 8: I am respectful toward myself and others when I'm in the blue zone.

Week 9 & 10: I make responsible choices when I'm in the yellow zone.
